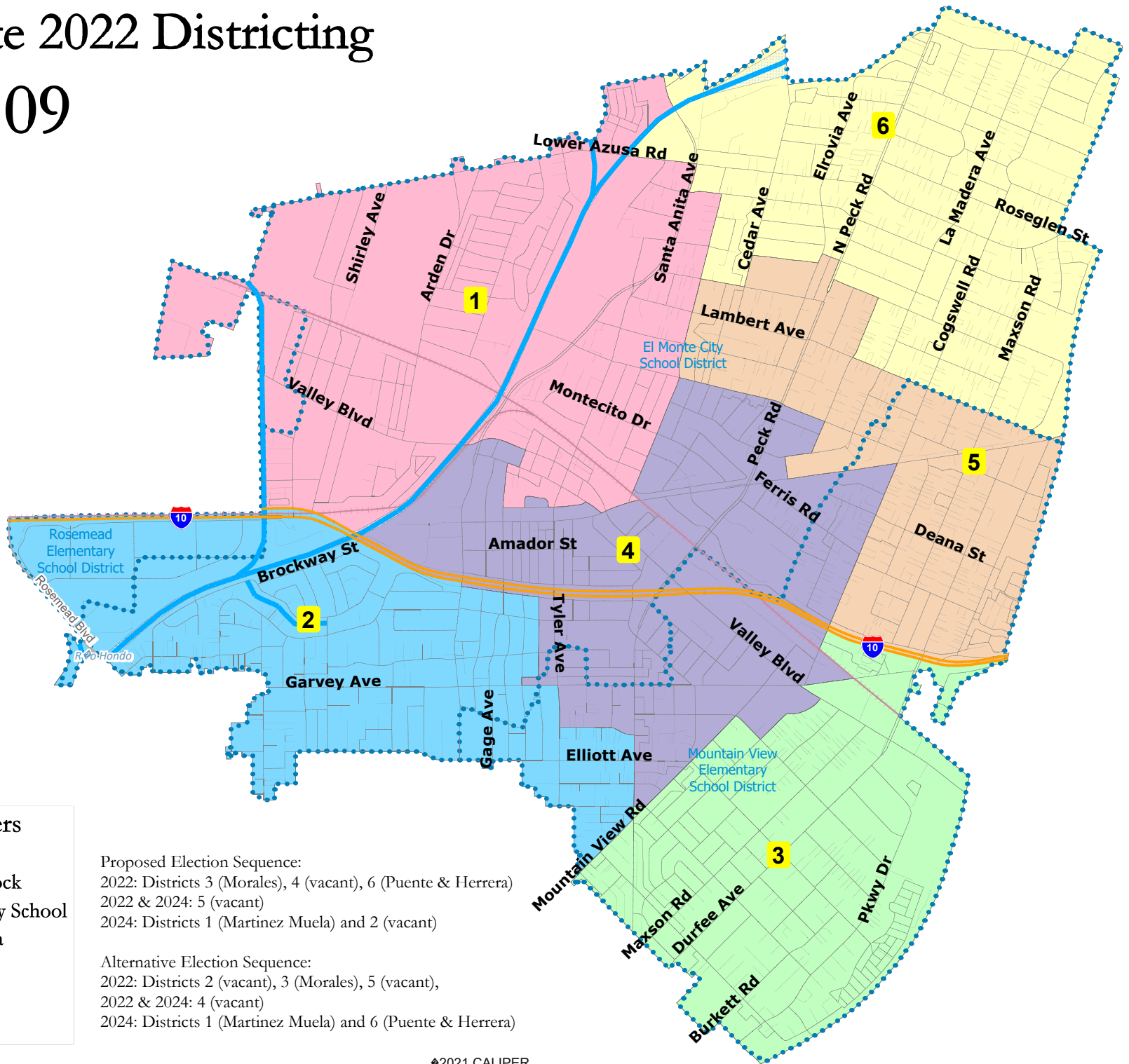


El Monte 2022 Districting
