

PHASE V

FINAL EVALUATION/REMEDIAL OR EXTENDED TRAINING PHASE

The fifth phase of field training is the trainee's last phase with an FTO. This training period will be two weeks long. The trainee will be assigned to his/her first FTO, if possible. The trainee's goal will be to demonstrate he/she can now work as an independent police officer in a one-officer patrol unit. During this phase, techniques will be polished, and the trainee's decision making will be watched and evaluated. The overall goal is **independence**. If applicable, the primary FTO will complete attestation of the trainee's ability to perform the duties of a solo patrol officer.

In the event that a trainee has not successfully progressed to the point of operating in the above capacity, this phase will have a secondary objective of allowing additional time for the trainee to complete Phase IV and enter into Phase V performance expectations.
