TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of El Monte (the "City") is seeking applications for its **Program Year (PY) 2023-2024 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs**. The City of El Monte is a direct recipient of federal funding provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and uses these funds to provide decent housing, suitable living environments, and expanded economic opportunities, principally for low- and moderate-income persons.

The City is seeking applications for CDBG and ESG funding from applicants (City and non-profit agencies) who are capable of providing eligible public service and/or capital improvement activities that will help the City meet the needs of its community and achieve the goals and objectives listed in the City's PY 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan and City priorities found at <https://www.ci.el-monte.ca.us/237/Plans-and-Reports>.

For the 2023-2024 program year, it is anticipated that the City will receive approximately \$1.5 million of CDBG funds and program income and to support CDBG-eligible activities and \$149,000 of ESG to support ESG-eligible activities. Eligible activities for CDBG must meet one of the following national objectives: 1) principally benefit low- and/or moderate-income persons; or eliminate slums and blight; or 3) meet an urgent need. All interested parties are encouraged to apply.

Applications will be released on January 05, 2023. All applications must be submitted through the ZoomGrants online application management system at <https://www.zoomgrants.com/gprop.asp?donorid=2258&limited=3911>.
